Neighborhood Alert!

During January – our neighborhood has been hit with break-ins at two homes and a potential attempt at another.

We believe there are people that are knocking on doors looking for information and if no one is home – attempting to break in.

The Board is working with our Wichita Community Police Officer on things we can do to better protect our homes. We have requested additional patrols through the neighborhood, and the beat officers are aware of our current concerns.

How you can help:

- Make sure you keep your doors locked and garage door closed when not in use.
- Keep outdoor lights on in the evening and keep your home as well lit as possible.
- If you have someone knock and ask for a wrong address/person or random information – contact 911 immediately to report the incident.
- If you have "pushy" salespeople come to the door do not let them in your home, you are encouraged to call 911 immediately.
- Lock your cars if they are not in the garage take out any valuables.
- Watch out for your neighbors WE are our best defense!

- To report an incident (after the fact) you can contact the Police Case desk 268-4221 to make a report over the phone OR contact our Community Police officer and he will make arrangements to meet with you to gather the information.
