They provide service to our neighborhood for a reduced price as long as we have a certain percentage of our residents contracted. Pool Items:

We have received several requests for new keys. As a reminder, new keys (SERGEANT brand) were issued last year. If your key has SERGEANT stamped on it, you have the current key for the Preston Trails pool. 
